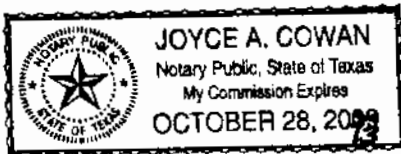

Jan. 15, 2010 -- Nearly 400 individuals donated to the Jeff Barton Campaign in 2009, according to filings released by the campaign today.

As it has done before, the Barton campaign went beyond what the law requires in its financial disclosure.

The filings for the last six months of 2009 show a median donation of less than \$10, with total donations of \$10,995.31.

In the first six months of the year -- including two large fundraisers -- the campaign reported raising \$42,587.50, with a median contribution of \$50.

That makes total contributions for 2009 of \$53,582.81.

Barton announced for Hays County Judge Jan. 4, and the campaign will not report funds raised since then until the next state reporting period, 30 days prior to the March 2 election. The current campaign contribution and expenditure reports cover the period through Dec. 31, before Barton -- a sitting county commissioner -- had formally announced.

"I'm really pleased that we're in such good financial condition," said Barton. "I'm particularly proud that we have so many small contributors and such a broad-based, grassroots campaign, with donors from every community in Hays County."

Barton said the strong fundraising results, even though he was not yet a candidate for county judge, give him a head start in the judge's race and will allow him to run a vigorous county-wide campaign.

"If you look at the number of donors, and the diversity of the people who are giving, and then you consider how many volunteers have stepped forward, you have to feel good about where we are," Barton said. "Since I announced for judge, donations and volunteers have really picked up -- something we'll be excited to show in our next reports."

Donations for July through December, the period covered in the reports filed today, show 112 people gave \$50 or less, and 128 total contributions. The campaign said the smallest donation was \$5, the largest \$2,000.

Total donors for the year are at least 382 -- probably more because some contributions shown as single individuals were actually families or couples.

"We've got a lot more small donors than big donors, but we're pretty strong in both categories, really," Barton said. "This is a Democratic campaign fueled on people power. We know how to be competitive -- and know how to win."
